Please be advised to set aside MYR800 – MYR1,500 (USD235 – USD435) per month as living expenses.

# HOW TO APPLY

Follow these application procedures.

## STEP 1

Submit your application at least six weeks (1.5 months) before the start of the intake to avoid any unnecessary delays in the admission process.

You will need to send in the Application for Admission and Accommodation form together with the following:

- 2 Photocopy sets of your whole passport including ALL the blank pages. Your passport should have at least 12 months' validity
- 8 Passport-sized photographs with light blue background (3.5 cm x 5 cm)
- 2 Certified true copies of all academic qualifications (In English Translation)
- 2 Certified true copies of English Language Proficiency (If applicable)
  - Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
  - International English Language Testing System (IELTS)
- Pre-arrival medical screening report
- No Objection Certificate (NOC) (Only applicable to students from Sub-Saharan Africa)
- Eligibility Letter (Only applicable to students from Nigeria)
- Release Letter & Attendance Record from your current institution (Only applicable to transferred Institute Students)
- Application & Visa Processing Fees\* (Inclusive of processing fees, medical insurance, medical screening and immigration fees) totaling MYR2,500 / approximate USD760. For payment details, please refer to [international.newinti.edu.my](http://international.newinti.edu.my)

## STEP 2

### A) Successful application

INTI will issue the Letter of Offer to you and will submit your application for student visa to the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) in Malaysia on your behalf\*. This process will take approximately 1 - 2 months.

### B) Unsuccessful application

INTI will inform you in writing

*\*Students who are already in Malaysia on a social visa are required to leave the country before the submission to EMGS for visa approval.*

## STEP 3

- Upon obtaining the Student Visa Approval Letter (VAL) from the Immigration Office, you are required to pay an advance tuition fee amounting to MYR16,000 (approximate USD4,650) being the "Prepaid Fee" before the Original VAL is sent to you. INTI will scan you a copy of the VAL (If necessary)
- Kindly bring the VAL together with your passport to the nearest Malaysian Embassy/Consulate as you are required to obtain a Single Entry Visa (SEV) before entering Malaysia (If applicable)

*Note: You might have to top up any balance upon enrolment if the total fees payable is higher than the Prepaid Fee.*

## STEP 4

Inform INTI of your arrival details at least five working days prior to your arrival in Malaysia, so that an INTI representative can pick you up at the airport in order to obtain clearance from the Immigration checkpoint.

## COMING TO INTI

1. Five working days before you arrive in Malaysia, email your Airport Arrival Form with details of your flight number and departure date, time and city to our International Office (Services) at the relevant campus.

2. We will then provide the name and contact details of the officer-in-charge.
3. Before departure, bring along the following documents:
  - i. Original Passport with validity at least 12 months.
  - ii. Original High School certificates and transcripts.
  - iii. Original copy of Visa Approval Letter (VAL) and Single Entry Visa (SEV) for nationals who require a visa to enter Malaysia.
  - iv. Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate is required for African nationalities.
4. Fill up the disembarkation card provided by the airline or obtainable at the airport arrival hall.
5. At the KLIA / KLIA2, proceed to the Immigration Office. Ask an airport staff for directions if you are not sure where it is.
6. At the Immigration Office, wait for an INTI officer to escort you through the Immigration checkout point for clearance. He or she will normally be wearing an INTI T-shirt and carrying an INTI sign.

Kindly take note that you must be picked up by INTI's representative at the airport in order to obtain clearance from the Immigration checkpoint. Therefore, it is very important that you notify us ahead of your arrival. Only a student with a Student Visa Approval Letter can get clearance to leave the airport.

7. The INTI accommodation officer will help you to check-in at the hostel (if you have booked a room in INTI's hostel). You may refer to INTI officer for further assistance.

## AFTER YOU HAVE ARRIVED

1. Report to International Office (Services) upon arrival or the next working day during office hours (Mon – Fri, 9am – 6pm) where you will need to:
  - Complete these forms: Enrollment Form, Letter of Undertaking (if required), Medical Check-up Form and Student Fees Refund Policy
  - Be briefed on International Office (Services) functions and responsibilities, Student Pass and Insurance issues
  - Obtain your Bank Letter to open a bank account
  - Arrange for a health / medical screening
2. Proceed to the Accommodation Office, where you will be briefed on hostel rules and regulations. An invoice will be generated for you to make payment.
3. You will have to sit for the English Placement Test unless you have been exempted from taking the test.
4. After getting your English Placement Test results, proceed with your programme enrollment with the assistance of an International Office (Services) staff. Then, proceed to the Finance Office to pay your hostel rent (If applicable). Registry officer will then issue you a Student ID and time-table.
5. Within 5 days of arriving, submit your passport to the International Office (Services) for student pass endorsement. You will be given a certified true copy of your passport info page and an acknowledgement slip. Failure to submit your original passport for student pass endorsement may result in illegal stay in Malaysia.
